
EMPLOYEE SATISFACTION AND HAPPINESS SURVEY 2022 - ACADEMIC STAFF


A: Experience at the Faculty





Fig 2. Reasons for Unsuccessful Teleconsultation (N=77)




Fig 1. Total number of successful teleconsultation and defaulters (N= 167)


